

*BlackKKKlansman* is a 2018 movie directed by Spike Lee, a famous american movie director. He is also a producer, writer and actor. He is well known among young people for being NBA 2K's director (the most famous basketball video game). The movie is based on a true story that took place in the 1970's. Ron Stallworth (John David Washington), a black officer, calls the KluKluxKlan and manages to plan a meeting with a member by pretending to be a racist white man. He then asks one of his coworker, Flip Zimmerman (Adam Driver), to go to the meeting for him, as Ron Stallworth, and to infiltrate the Klan. As a Klan member, Zimmerman would have to go through hard times and to say horrible things, such as "The Shoah is one of the best stuff that ever happened", being Jewish himself.

I have pretty much appreciated the whole movie, thus there are not really things that I did not liked. I could say however, that I've hated the Klan's members and their ideas, but it is more like an admiration to the actors : they were acting so well that I ended up hating them for real.

I liked the fact that the movie was based on a real story because it showed us that crazy things also happens in real life (Stallworth is indeed one crazy man) and not only in movies and cartoons. Furthermore, it reminded us that racism and communitarianism was already a strong reality in the past and that, (with the footages at the end) even today, these problems are far from being resolved. (PS : The clothes and the hairstyles were actually pretty cool, I wish I was born in the 1970's).

To me, the movie was a really good one. I was shocked by human violence and intolerance for his fellow men, even though I was already aware of it. I laughed at Stallworth's actions (especially at the end when he tells Duke he is a black man). I would definitely recommend this film. The last movie I watched on the subject was *Malcolm X*, it was a much darker movie so it think it was interesting for me to see two differents ways to treat the same subject. Now I want to keep watching this type of movie, the next one might be *12 Years a slave* thanks to you.
